
STADIUM OBSTACLE RELAY



Be there to see if they pick Army or Navy to be victorious.




Saturday, December 14TH | 11:55AM - 12:55PM Lincoln Financial Field

TO LINCOLN Financial field

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Take PATCO from New Jersey or SEPTA's Broad Street Subway to the game. From Center City, take the Broad Street Line (Orange Line) south to the last stop, NRG Station/Sports Complex.

FROM I-76 EAST

OPTION #1: Take I-76 to Exit 349 (Sports Complex), make a right off the exit onto Broad Street. Follow signs for parking.

OPTION #2: Take I-76 to Packer Avenue, Exit 350. Bear right onto Packer Avenue, turn left onto Broad Street and follow signs for parking.

FROM I-95 NORTH

OPTION #1: Take I-95 North past airport and Navy Yard to Broad Street, Exit 17. From the right-hand lane, follow to stadium parking. For Army-Navy game day, please be aware Exit 17 from I-95 North may be CLOSED. If so, please see option #2.

OPTION #2: Take I-95 North to Packer Avenue, Exit 19. Bear right off exit to Packer Avenue to Darien Street, turn left and follow signs for parking.

FROM I-95 SOUTH

OPTION #1: Take I-95 South to Packer Avenue, Exit 19 (bear right off exit). Bear right at 2nd light onto Packer Avenue. Turn left onto Darien Street and follow signs for parking.

OPTION #2: Take I-95 South to Broad Street, Exit 17 (right-hand lane). Follow into stadium.



PARKING

Parking in official lots is \$40 per car. Parking for oversized vehicles is \$80. Prices at private lots may vary. Fans with an ADA license plate or placard will be permitted to park in handicap-accessible locations, as available. Pre-paid parking is available, please visit PhillyLovesArmyNavy.com

TAILGATING

Tailgating is permitted in the following lots of the Sports Complex: A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, K, M, N and P.

STADIUM GATES

Gates open at 11:00 AM. Re-Entry is not permitted. Fans are encouraged to arrive early.

HOTELS

STADIUM BAG POLICY

Fans may carry only the following style and size of bag into the stadium:

- Vendor Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12".
- The bags may be hand-carried or have a shoulder strap.
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziplock or similar).
- Small clutch bag approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap. This can be carried separately or within a plastic bag.
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection.

The following items are prohibited inside the Stadium:

Alcoholic BeveragesCans & Glass bottlesUmbrellas

All bags will be searched upon entry. Still, digital and video cameras are permitted.
